

## Protection of data: Cloud act

### Your data is at all times protected against disclosure

WhistleB customer data is protected against any disclosure. Customer data is protected by encryption where the customer have full and sole control of the encryption key. It is not possible to access customer data by any third party such as for example WhistleB, sub-suppliers or an authority. You, as a WhistleB customer, are the only party that can decrypt and give anyone access to your data.

### Prevention of crimes

The Cloud Act applies to US citizens and is an initiative to prevent cross border criminal activities, and gives US authorities certain rights to request data, without impinging on the privacy rights of the individual or the duties of the cloud service provider to protect those rights.

The Cloud act gives the Cloud Service Provider the right to reject a request if complying would be contradictory to local privacy laws, for example the EU GDPR. Circumstances where a request will be rejected are if the customer is not a U.S. person and does not reside in the U.S or if disclosure would "create a material risk that the provider would violate the laws" of the foreign government.

### WhistleB is EU based and governed by GDPR

WhistleB is an EU based company, governed under EU law including GDPR. GDPR governs that personal data remains within EU. Any request for disclosure of data would create a material risk to violate GDPR. Request received by WhistleB from any authority would be immediately informed to our customers. WhistleB will not, and cannot, disclose customer data to anyone.
